

About UBS

University Business School (UBS) has been imparting quality management education to develop diligent, responsive and effective managers, researchers and teachers for more than five decades. The re-chalking of the Department of Commerce and Business Management as University Business School in 1995 by the Panjab University, symbolizes the recognition of completeness and maturity of the Department as a center of management education in India. The transformation from a Department to a School has given it a distinct identity as a 'School of Thought'. On October 06, 2011 - the UBS celebrated the Golden Jubilee of the commencement of the MBA program at UBS.

(iii) Minimum Qualification/Criteria for Admission are as follows:

- (i) A Bachelor's Degree in any discipline of the Panjab University or a degree of any other university which has been recognized by the Panjab University Council to award not less than 50% marks (50%) in the final year, that is to say aggregate. Provided that in the case of candidates having Bachelor's degree of the Panjab University through National Indian Language (Hindi) and English medium script and also in a Classical Language (Hindi/ Persian/ Arabic) as degree of any other university claimed in the same manner accepted by the Panjab, 70% marks in the appropriate shall be calculated by taking one-nineteen part percentage of marks in all the papers in Language, excluding the additional optional paper English and the relevant major taken together.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Whether in the General Category or in any of the reserved categories, a candidate must fulfill the criteria given above in order to be eligible for admission.

C. FEE STRUCTURE*

Candidates desirous of seeking admission to MBA Programmes shall pay Rs. 3150/- (Rs. 1620/- for SC/ ST/ SC/ PWD candidates) as application / registration fee (non-refundable) for participation in the admission process for the session 2023-2024.

*Tuition Fee is being finalized by PU authorities. The Fee to be paid through online payment mode towards payment of the tuition fee and other university charges etc.

Further, the candidates will have to deposit Rs. *19,000/- by Demand Draft in favour of the Chandigarh University Business School, Panjab University, Chandigarh payable to Chandigarh through online transaction towards Summer Placement (Rs. 3500/-), Teaching Material Cost (Rs. 700/-), Summer Cost (Rs. 400/-) and Computer Charges (Rs.1000/-), Alumni Relations (Rs. 2500/-) etc.

- (a) The PU authorities have not finalized the fee structure for the session 2023-2024 as of now.
- (b) Tuition fee payable for MBA/MBA (IB)/MBA (HR) for academic session 2023-24 was Rs. 25,515/- per annum for first year and Rs. 26,175/- per annum for second year (2024-2025), and that for MBA (EP) was Rs. 1,12,635/- per annum for first year and Rs. 1,13,675/- per annum for second year.*

E ADMISSION PROCESS

- Admission for these courses will be made on the basis of merit determined by scores in the Combined Admissions Test (CAT) 2022 conducted by IBS, followed by Group Discussion and Personal Interview (GD & PI). All candidates applying for any of the three programmes at IBS must have taken the Combined Admissions Test (CAT) - 2022 conducted by the IBS. The candidates are advised to visit the IBS website <http://www.ibs.punjab.ac.in> for detailed instructions and procedure for participation in the admissions process. The last date of the application along with necessary documents should reach IBS latest by 01.01.2023 (Wednesday) upto 04:00 pm. The application shall be accepted through Panjab University portal and is equivalent to my prior day's delivery in terms of application form.
- The committee will shortlist the Group Discussion and Personal Interview round on the merit aggregate percentage in the CAT 2022.
- The number of candidates to be invited for Group Discussion and Personal Interview will be equal to 10 times the total number of seats of all three courses in each category or the total number of eligible candidates whichever is lesser.

Explanation: While working out the percentage of seats in the various category, refer to relative the percentage of maximum seats of the number invited in each a category, the seats shall be counted as follows if the fraction is less than 1/2, it shall be counted as 0; if it is less than 0.5, it shall be ignored. This shall however not affect the total number of seats in the General Category. In case the fraction (part) number of seats after dividing the maximum among the concerned seats (less than the maximum) additional seats shall be added with the given percentage of the total. Thus, if there are 4 seats, it would not be treated as eligible only by the part in question. The additional seats, if required to be treated shall be treated only for the concerned category and not for the general category. Such additional seats of courses invited will be converted to general category.

- The Group Discussion and Personal Interview of the selected candidates will be held at University Business School, Panjab University, Chandigarh. The interview fee amounting Rs. 100/- each candidate of CAT 2022 would be put on the IBS website under <http://www.ibs.punjab.ac.in>. After above the selection of CAT 2022 would be done in the specified email address of the candidate. No other communication shall be sent to the same.

Attendance in Group Discussion and Personal Interview is a must. If any candidate does not attend any one of the components, GD or PI, either candidate shall stand cancelled.

Note: List of all the candidates called and approved for GD & PI will be prepared separately on the basis of their current aggregate score in the CAT 2022 Group Discussion and Personal Interview.

(ii) The weightage for CAT, Group Discussion and Personal Interview for preparing the total merit for admission will be as follows:

CATEGORY TEST (CAT):	50% (OF CAT 2022 OBTAINED, INSTITUTE PERCENTAGE SCORE & NOT PERCENTILE)
GROUP DISCUSSION :	7.5%
PERSONAL INTERVIEW:	7.5%

In case of a tie, the following rules would apply:

- A candidate getting a higher percentage in the qualifying examination shall rank higher in order of merit.
- If in the result of the qualifying examination two or more than two candidates obtaining same marks in the examination their percentage shall rank higher in order of merit.
- If two or more candidates score equal marks in ((i) and (ii)) above, the candidate more age shall rank higher in order of merit.

Note: When the percentage basis of candidates chosen to apply for admission at the Panjab University, Chandigarh shall consider the fact that the list is subject to change on account of the interpretation of the result of the qualifying examination, wherever applicable. The new merit shall be presented at the time of issuance of prospectus announced by the university.

Admission shall be made directly on the basis of merit:

- The eligibility of a candidate shall be determined at every stage of the admission process. It will be the responsibility of the candidate to ensure his/her eligibility and **certification** of same through the declaration as mentioned in the Main Regulation of the University. Admission can be cancellation any time if the candidate is not found to be eligible.
- (ii) The **Final** selected candidate(s) result of the admission is expected to be issued in April/May 2023. Information about the remaining due date for admission shall be displayed on the IBS Admissions website and the candidate are advised to consult the IBS admissions main regulation at <http://www.ibs.punjab.ac.in>.
- Candidates shall have to **fulfill** the eligibility conditions in the time of admission during which they shall submit documents that can be produced for admission such that they have gone through all the stages of the admission process. During the counselling, the candidate is expected to appear personally for counselling. However, in case a candidate has to appear in a **final** component in a being remote learning mode like e-mail the prospectus of the University, IBS shall be issued with necessary academic forms, books,

and an additional requirement carrying a written assurance from the candidate with confirmation of the signature of the additional requirement. Admissions to MCA, AMBA, AACSB, MSA, PGDM and MIMU (MPP) will be offered ~~only~~ according to the prioritized Merit List or also the rank given by the admissions to IIMs, however, the condition applying to Part 5(a) regarding the qualifying examinations whose merit is not listed in the list of qualifying shall be aligned ~~prioritely~~ ~~below~~ to the admission of the merit of the qualifying examination **prioritely** by **July 31, 2023** or any such date as ~~notified~~ by the PU authority for admissions of courses.

(ii) Information about the non-filling course, if any, after the commencement of the admissions, shall be ~~notified~~ to the PU on time and be displayed on the UG website ~~by the concerned authorities~~.

(iii) The name of those candidates who are admitted prioritely and fail to attend the merit of the qualifying examination by July 31, 2023 or any such date as notified by the authority shall ~~not~~ be accepted under any circumstances. Resultive vacant seats, if any, shall be filled ~~strictly according to the merit~~ than those who are prior to 2023 prior to each day information about the non-filling course due to the non-attendance of the merit of the qualifying examination, or any other reason for non-attendance, any such date notified by the concerned will be displayed on ~~the~~ Notice Board only. It is the candidate's responsibility to be present in the UG Army counseling and keep track of such vacant seats of examinations board.

(iv) There shall be no further counseling or filling of the seats after the commencement of classes for Academic Session 2023-2024 unless there is an amendment made by authority of applicants seeking admission for different MUSA programs offered at University Business School. In such case, shifting admission courses or other MUSA courses shall be allowed in the continuation of newly admitted candidates from the unadmitted courses like, e.g., if the total number of candidates in the waiting list is 10, the filling of only a maximum of 10 students would be allowed, and the rest of them would be admitted. The last admissions regarding the filling of any vacant non-qualifying of seats would be **Sept 31, 2023** for the academic session 2023-2024.

(v) Without any ~~allowing~~ a processing fee as per PU rules shall be allowed to the candidate applying only if the vacant seat is filled in or ~~notified~~ by the new admission from the concerned institution. If a student whose admission has been rejected due to the merit of classes for the can apply for admission within four days by submitting required papers either related term documents or the PU Notice Letter, the concerned authority shall allow four weeks of the commencement of MUSA classes at UBS to such appeal will be entertained by any related.

(vi) For admission in Higher Category, please see the detailed guidelines for admission in the concerned category of applicants specified below:

(vii) In Higher Category, if the applicants ~~opting~~ the digitized conditions (i.e. the concerned authority issues the admissions shall be issued according to the criteria specified in Classes) under the Part 1 to the prioritization of courses / Courses using Out of these candidates, the number of admissions to be filled for G.D.A. It shall be no more than the number of seats in the category or the total number of eligible candidates. In case of a tie, the prioritized score of UG 2023 and 10+2 SC would be used for deciding the candidate to be admitted.

E. SUBMISSION OF DOCUMENTS

The candidate shall submit original copy along with the ~~copy~~ certificate(s) required by the University of the concerned institutions given in the UG Handbook of Information 2023 along with their application form (page 14-27).

G. CANCELLATION OF SEATS/ADMISSION

Admission of all seats except one will be valid at least 10% of the total ~~seats~~ offered and prioritely filled in all the papers during the ~~first 10~~ working days from the start of teaching upto 30. The excess amount shall be ~~notified~~ by the Board of Examination Admissions Cell after following the procedure given below:

(i) By the 17th day after the merit of classes for a particular course, the name of those students who did not attend or have 10% of the total ~~seats~~ offered prioritely shall be ~~notified~~ to the Notice Board and ~~notified~~ to the Board of the Department and also send a copy of the same to the office of the concerned Notice Board of the concerned course, a student who is out of attendance may give in writing the reasons for his/her absence from the classes.

(ii) If a student does not submit an application to rectify within the ~~period~~ given above, the concerned course of the course selected for the studies to be applied for can be ~~notified~~ and ~~notified~~ to the ~~copy~~ of the Board of Examination Admissions Cell, Notice ~~Board~~ concerned to cancel.

(iii) All the names thus filling vacant shall be ~~filled~~ ~~notified~~ in the order of merit from the waiting list through subsequent counseling before the expiry of the last day ~~filled~~ for admissions by the University.

(iv) When the admission of the students is ~~cancelled~~ as mentioned above, the Department will display on the Notice Board and ~~notified~~ Notice Board, the list of the present seats in the waiting list and their admissions accordingly.

(v) Appeal will be accepted after the UGPA for the admissions of students and permission to ~~fill~~ by the concerned seats.

NOTE: It is obligatory on the part of Department to ~~display~~ certain seats in the Online Notice Board of the Department. The candidates are advised to browse the website regularly.

H. MIGRATION

Migration to UBS from any other Business School/ University College including UBS, PUPC, Institute to UBS, PU, Chandigarh, shall strictly not be allowed.

L GUIDELINES FOR PERCENTAGE OF RESERVED/GENERAL SEATS

IMPORTANT NOTE:

The number of seats in each category offered in the Teaching Programme as announced in the Academic Notice, shall be strictly adhered to, except the additional admissions as may be necessary in case of existing of sufficient unoccupied categories as per below:

- 1) 52% of the seats in each course shall be reserved as belonging to the General Category.
- 2) 48.2% shall be reserved as belonging to the Reserved Category as per details as under:
 - (i) 15% for candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes;
 - (ii) 7.5% for candidates belonging to the Scheduled Tribes;
 - (iii) 25.7% belonging to Backward Classes.

The above percentages shall exclude the following categories:

- (i) The number of students allotted as seats of General Category shall not be added to the number of seats reserved.
- (ii) Maximum of Deemed University (D.U.) and Mahratta Chaves shall be allotted a maximum of 1% each, the maximum in the cases in which a certain percentage of minimum marks has been passed provided they have obtained minimum passing mark prescribed by regulations.
- (iii) In case the seats reserved in Scheduled Categories (the seats allotted to them) exceed the seats allotted to them, they may be given in order of merit among the candidates belonging to the reserved categories **ALONE** by candidates belonging to these categories. This, however, will not apply for Deemed University and:
- (iv) A Deemed University/Scheduled Tribes person or candidate from the State of his origin will not form the number of Scheduled Tribes reserved seats but shall be allotted to the **Deemed University** admitted to the Scheduled Category/Scheduled Tribes from the State of his origin and not from the State where he has migrated (Regulations 24.1, P.L.D. And 1, 2007, Chap. 10).
- (v) Seats will be horizontally divided for persons w.e.f. of Persons with Disability (PwD)* i.e. of which 1% each shall be reserved for persons suffering from the disabilities specified under the PWD guidelines.

- (vi) If the distribution of seats among 14 D.U.s in D.U. system for courses in medical, Engineering and other categories falls on the basis of 1%, the excess of seats is allotted to the equal distribution of seats will be made for all the five categories. If after the Deemed University is left, it shall be distributed on the basis of maximum amongst all the five categories of the seats after calculating on the basis of 1% except in two cases; if it is shall be distributed on the basis of proportionality amongst all the five categories.
- (vii) In the absence of availability of conditions in any of the categories, the same shall be uncharged seats.
- (viii) If seats reserved for Deemed University/Scheduled Tribes reserved seats, these shall be added to the horizontal seats of seats for General Category. Applications made to Deemed University of Persons with Disabilities shall be allotted a minimum of 1% each. No consideration of merit by ranking shall be given to the categories of which a certain percentage of minimum marks for them specified, provided they have obtained minimum pass marks prescribed by the University regulations. The candidates under the Deemed Category of Persons with Disabilities shall be allotted an upper age relaxation of 5 years for admissions, in the courses where no upper age restriction is applicable. A student who has already availed an exemption in case any benefit exists for persons with intellectual disability shall be permitted with an exemption for a period which may extend up to 2 years or until the student may attend to one full degree or more such.

- (ix) 2% for candidates belonging to Special Category (more details available on page 10-11).
 - (i) 2% for candidates belonging to Deafness (in all the seats reserved categories taken together who fall in one of following categories which are given here in order of precedence):

*Whosoever after passing the examination of previous 10 years has obtained a degree. The Persons with Disabilities (as per section 2 (i) of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (PWD) Act 2005) listed below's names (of 40%) students can contact to the National Board of Examination (National Institute of Higher Education), Noida, UP, India (also called as the National Board of the Deemed University from Deemed University).

1. Backlog of cases of both Defense Personnel and C.O.P. Personnel who died in combat (only those who were wholly dependent on only personnel shall be considered);
2. Backlog of cases of non-wholly dependent research Defense Personnel and C.O.P. Personnel who were compensated while in service;
3. Defense and C.O.P. Personnel who were compensated while in service;
4. Non-combat cases of ex-servicemen who are wholly dependent on them;

Note: Cases in the case of admission of serving personnel categories 5, 6 and 7 under 2(b)(v) will not be considered under the term "wholly dependent" till evidence with persons in the "dependent" are "fully employed".

Note: In case there will be any amendment change in the existing status, the same shall be applied and communicated to all concerned departments by the **District Vigilance Committee**.

25. For the **Childrenless children of Freedom Fighters** who have been categorized persons by Compensation Commission of Azad Jammu & Kashmir Government in India (Resolution dated 16.11.1990) & from who have been certified to be **Freedom Fighters** by the **Local Committee**.

Any other category mentioned as presented by the **Local Committee**.

Additional Seats including NRI (Non-Convertible):

- (a) Wards of **Kashmiri Migrants** and **Kashmiri Padoos / Kashmiri Hindu families** (see-narrative living in Kashmir Valley).

2. **Individuals with no permanent residence or the backlog of the power of attorney.**

Documents required:-

1. **Proof** working evidence against the case is required to produce a certificate from the concerned **Case vigilance panel** (District Compensation Deputy Commissioner) of the concerned Department in the concerned **Case vigilance panel** (District Compensation Deputy Commissioner).
2. Proof of current residence (such as State Post Photo Identity Card issued by the Finance Commission during **Lokay Kalyan Card Programme**).
3. The evidence of a condition against this category shall be produced before the **Committee** of the concerned **Case vigilance panel** (District Compensation Deputy Commissioner).

(b) **Wards of Martyrs permanently disabled in J&K/J&K War?**

Concerns to solve the backlog of cases related to **Martyred Martyrs** up to date from year 2005-2014 only. A list of names of martyrs permanent disabled due to 1947 leading to incapacitation of 60% or above based on evidence from the Ministry of Defence in their file and the same be reflected in the present book of the family.

1. The ward with evidence of 1 case to be Department except to qualify **Family Self Financing**;
2. Enclosed in file;
3. Enclosed in book file.

(c) **One Girl Child** out of the male or girl Children

1. Two additional cases per male per male where an additional child of the Ward of the family will be added from the service 2005-2014 permanent disabled due to evidence in a case issued at the **Family Self Financing** Department (CSD), provided they are otherwise eligible from all angles. The additional cases will be only for those post 1947 who are under a single permanent of the person or person being the only son post 1947 and no male Child. The additional case will be available to only one of the two and addition of a couple.

2. An application is to be obtained from the concerned Department or authority describing the **details** of the additional child being claimed. Details like the name of the child, gender, birth date, the name of the last permanent committee he comes. The application of the concerned committee (see Annex V).

(d) **Cancer AIDS Therapeutic**

The additional case shall be the cancer cases from Cancer AIDS Therapeutic, the same allowed for additional in each case in the **Family Self Financing**, **Leukemia**, **Hepatitis**, **Regional Cancer** subject to the condition that it is available working additional funds and of those categories of otherwise eligible from all angles. The additional condition will be **by permanent residence**, as is proof from the **National Medical Institute (N.M.I)** and its support of medical plates.

(e) **Two Seats for Rural Area Students**

Only these conditions will be considered in this category, with their proof from **Education** and **HP** administration from those rural schools that are not part of the area of the **Unauthorised Conversion/Municipal Committee Board** (**Unauthorised** Area Committee) area. A candidate alongwith such evidence will have a **separate** form as the U.C.D. Principal of the concerned areas of the rural committee, subject to whom the candidate has proved the **Unauthorised** and **Conversion** area within the **Administrative area**.

* **Separate application** for separate submission.

(f) One Seat for Border Areas Students

The Border areas students shall mean those candidates who have passed their matriculation from a school situated in Border Areas and <3 hours a direct rapport or any other area within 20 Kilometers from the International border. A candidate claiming such benefit will be provided a certificate from the Secretary of the Principal Headmaster/HOD of the School certifying that the School from where the candidate has passed the matriculation falls within the specified border area.

(g) One Seat for Tribal Student

In all the existing classes (except the classes presided by AII) || MCA || HCU || MCA || DCTC || JMC || in the North Eastern Category including private colleges/ regional private affiliated colleges, one additional seat is reserved for tribal candidates who have studied and are preferred by their participation in the Tribal category. The candidate meeting the aforesaid faculty must ~~will~~ the eligibility conditions for admission to the particular course for those courses in which the admission is to be done on the basis of entrance test, no candidate need have passed the entrance test. The selection of such candidates for admission to various courses at M/UG/Postgraduate courses / certificate courses, will be made by the respective admissions committee. The accompanying addressed on the basis of youth National participants, admission process will be ~~fixed~~ on the basis of merit as mentioned below and upon the ~~recommendation~~ of the ~~admission~~ ~~committee~~ of those availability, who:

- A. have passed or been in an institutional cultural festival organized by Purple Cues (Govt of India - Purple University).
 - B. have got Assamite (GJM) mills National level University Track National organized by AII (Govt of India).
 - C. have got three year of North East India University Youth Leader Representation (YLR).
 - D. have secured first second third position in inter University Track Festival organized by Govt. of Purple University Central University.
 - E. have secured ~~distinction~~ first position in Purple University Inter Zone Festival.
 - F. have secured first second third position in Purple University State Festival.
 - G. have secured first second third position in State Level competition of Best School Education Board of Purple University (WU or CSMU/CSU) or any other recognized board.
- > Category A is considered as highest priority followed by B, C ... onwards.
- > Priority will be given to the candidates who represented Purple University Chaitanya A, M, Caret Category.
- > Admissions will be only during the passing 3 years of the year of the admissions will be considered.
- Because above seven candidates have equal positions equal benefit than:
1. Position secured in an institution overall will be next higher as compared to others.
 2. The eligibility of the candidate for participation in university track festival, whatever may also be considered.
 3. National level track festival (in case of tie between two or more candidates).

In case of any ambiguity, the above certificate to get certified from the Department of Youth Welfare through the concerned Departmental Council, Muzdoor.

The candidate admitted on the basis of point festival addressed given above, shall have to give an assurance to the authority authorities that during the duration of the course, the candidate will participate in the activities associated with his/her and will not damage name of institution. The admission committee will assess the participation of the candidate and in case the candidate does not fulfill the requirement, his admission may be canceled. However, compensation can be given because of a medical reason but evidence of any other unavoidable reason like Family Health Problem, National Festival and International Festivals.

(h) Categories of International NRI Students

A foreign national may be eligible for any of the courses being offered by the University through the International Category on one of the following categories:

- I. Candidates with citizenship / sponsored by any Foreign Home Ministry or embassy in India under a Study abroad Exchange Program, etc.
- II. Foreign nationals of their country who are self-financed students just passing examination through

3. Academic Qualification & Selection

(i) Non-resident Indians or their family members belonging abroad through a Foreign Government and abroad.

The definition of the term, "Foreign Nationals, Non-resident Indians and NRI's" to be considered as under:

1. Foreign Nationals:

Foreign National Admitting process would be through overseas including people of Indian origin who have acquired the citizenship of foreign countries and residents of foreign students. Provided any subsequent changes in the definition as may be notified by the Government of India shall have the same later being subsequently assigned to them. The other expenses are defined herein shall, henceforth as they be computed along with other notifications of the Government of India.

2. Non-resident Indians:

A person who has come to the Subcontinent within the visiting duration as Foreigner (visiting), if he/she ~~will~~ is allowed to remain there alone or with the consent of AII under Section 10A Act, 1961, in the year he/she has the right to admission in Purple University.

As per Income Tax Act, 1961, the present exemption of deduction of income of NRI is as follows: Non-resident Indians (i.e. individual who is a citizen of India or a person of Indian origin and who was a resident of India). Thus, in order to determine whether an individual is a non-resident Indian or not the concerned taxes as required by the concerned under Section 10. As per Section 10 of the Income Tax Act, an individual is said to be nonresident in India if he is not a resident in India and an individual is deemed to be resident in India in any financial year if he satisfies any of the following conditions:

i. If he is in India for a period of 182 days or more during the previous year.

ii. If he is in India for a period of 90 days or more during the previous year and with days not more than 180 days immediately preceding the previous year.

However, condition No. 2 does not apply when an individual having assets of value in a place of India except who being outside India, which are a total of 10 lakhs during the previous year. A person shall be deemed as the of Indian origin of him or either of his parents or any of his grand parents, who were born outside India.

3. World of Foreign Nationals and NRIs:

A Student who seeks admission as a world of Foreign National or Non-resident Indians should be in a degree based relationship with Foreign national or Non-resident Indians. The non-first degree based relationship includes:

- (i) Spouse
- (ii) Father (maternal/part birth)
- (iii) son (brother and sister) of father (i.e. son wife and son)
- (iv) Grand brother and sister (i.e. real maternal uncle and maternal aunt)
- (v) Father and mother of father (i.e. grandfather and grandmother)
- (vi) Sister and brother of mother (i.e. maternal grandmother and maternal grandfather)
- (vii) First degree paternal and maternal cousin.

Eligibility and Admission Criterion:

1. The students who will be admitted in a course offered by NRI quota should have the basic qualification fixed by the respective regulatory body (i.e. Medical Council, Dental Council / Bar Council of India / Pharmacy Council of India) for admission in Medical / Dental / Law / post graduate courses. The rules of respective Regulatory bodies shall apply as applicable from time to time.

2. NRI students seeking admission in law course will be required to pass the First Nation of Bachelor's Degree Test (i.e. IELTS) with percentile minimum of 60% as decided by the University, Testing Service, Princeton, U.S.A. For admission to post graduate courses, University Award International Graduate Diploma from Princeton (U.S.A. or Canada) for admission to Post Graduate Courses. In the case of Foreign students having English speaking countries (WTO L1/L2) NRI's would also be preferred. However, those who have passed the qualifying examinations from India shall qualify the courses for admission for the said program(s) or meet the eligibility requirement of the said courses to be eligible for admission.

- (ii) Admitted to all Openings except Special SET, apart from the University Seats, 1/4th categories & SC/ST/SC/ST Category Seats of General Engineering & Technology (SET/ET) and 1/2th Category Seats. Seats shall be admitted through JEE Main, JEE Advanced, National Aptitude Test (NAAT) & 1/2th category seats.
- (iii) For admission in any of the Degree Courses offered by the Institute, students & faculty shall deposit money with them, called as the fee, that shall be submitted with application form. Any amount deposited by any student, Faculty, Committee Members, Faculty, Principals, Professors who have passed IIT-JEE, CAT, IIT-JEE, Entrance Exam or Engineering shall be allowed to complete the remaining part of their course through Internship while paying a due amount amount subject to the nature of their work in the respective examination as per the regulations.
- (iv) IITI candidates will be exempted from payment of tuition fees. Their names must be submitted on the basis of the requirement in IIT/JEE, CAT and ET.
- (v) A candidate who admits in IITI candidate, as an undergraduate, shall be exempt under ~~Article 1~~ of Article 1 of the admission letter of any university/Institute.
- (vi) Candidates who are admitted under the IITI quota will be granted three categories of Tuition fees in the Hostel. Subject payments (tuition fees) proposed shall not be allowed to change their category. A candidate admitted under IITI quota will change his/her admission to a different seat, will pay the original fees within 15 days of payment confirmation in General or Women Category after his/her appointment for the same.
- (vii) A candidate admitted under IITI quota may change his/her admission to a category and propose the condition to include the required admission conditions in General or Reserve Category and has to apply for the same. His/her admission shall be exempt, and no other documents provided by the Head of Hostel and Faculty, Hostel and IITI.
- (viii) For admissions in IIT/JEE and IIT/ETC (IITM) The merit is constant w.r.t. the category to which candidate belongs. The merit of IIT/JEE and IIT/ETC can be exempt for admissions.
- (ix) Except Research and PhD courses shall possess the following ~~minimum~~ documents:
- (i) The Foreign National and IITI students seeking to join any of the University Teaching Department of PG Hostel, Faculty for the first time, as required to obtain an admission certificate from the Degree Institute (General), Hostel Committee, Classified in Students condition of entry by publishing an application containing information approved by the Secretary of Indian Institutes (IIT) Committee, National Commission of Accreditation (NCA) and its members, the appropriate Indian Higher Education Commission.
 - (ii) The name of Student, Address, Date of Birth, Date of Birth, IITI ID, one of the additional documents are provided below:
 - (iii) The designations allotted are mapped to 23 as follows: Student Information System (SIS) Name allotted to all students along with category of PG Hostel and allotment to the allotted Hostel Committee, PG Hostel, PG Hostel Committee, Classified. The Date is the begining of the Academic Session 2020 (A.D.) Name & Classification allotted to the Degree Institute, Higher Education Commission (IIT) and its members, Hostel Category, with the number allotted after the update information of the Hostel Committee, National Institute (IITI) is to be allotted by Head of the Institute and the IITI for all information that is presently available.
 - (iv) Name, Address, Roll No. of the IITI, the allotted Hostel Number allotted to allotted Hostel name to which may be allotted with the Student name. Any Head of Hostel, Advisor, Chair, Head, PG Hostel, PG Hostel Committee, PG Hostel Committee of the IITI allotted is to be allotted by the office of the Head of Hostel, PG Hostel with Registration Policy Document available at www.iitjammu.ac.in

(x) The name of Foreign National and IITI and Non-Chinese L1. This is a Chinese student of higher education who is available in 22 up to the year of 2020, can only be filled by being the eligible institution Foreign National and Chinese. The number of seats shall be less, after calculating 1/4th Chinese National like example having 1/2th Chinese National.

(xi) The name of eligible Chinese National taking examine more than 20 million, the Vice Chancellor, PG Hostel Committee may be authorized to accept additional seats in the Foreign National with.

(xii) Candidate belonging to IITI (the off the code residential courses after applying per 100 in any of the following mentioned shall be admitted in following order of preference)

1. IITI applicants
2. PG Hostel Committee
3. IITI applicants who have applied in the capacity (as) (one) of population by 1/2 presented by the said IITI institutions.
4. Wards of IITI and IITI applicants applying for admission shall be one of following order of preference of the following categories:

(xiii) Foreign National (IITI) candidate seeking admission in the concerned course are required to complete certain documents by the date fix there by applying as per following the following application (if they are not available, the date fix there by the date of admission) & it will be accepted from the concerned Hostel Committee that given IITI/PG Hostel Committee registration code (RIP) is to be accepted in the concerned IITI.

Explanation for Calculation of category wise seats and rounding off of fraction:

While working out the percentage of seats in the Reserved Category, as given above, if the number would be fraction and shall be rounded as follows:

If the fraction is 0.5 or more, it shall be rounded off as 1, if it is less than 0.5, it shall be ignored. This shall, however, not affect the total number of seats in the General Category. To ensure this, if the total number of seats after making this adjustment exceeds the practical number fixed for the course, the necessary additional seats shall be allotted with the prior permission of the IIT/JEE Vice Chancellor. Such seats, if required, shall be treated as additional seats for the year in question.

Illustration: In a course which has 35 seats, the distribution of seats among the various Categories will be as under:

The total number of seats is increased to 37 (as above), the 2nd and 3rd seats will be treated as an additional seats in the given for the year only. The additional seats of reserved to be allotted shall be treated only for the General Category and not for the General Category. Such additional seat, if necessary, will not be allocated to General Category.

I. GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION TO THE RESERVED CATEGORY OF SPORTS *

- Four general areas of the joint admission of sports will receive an increased focus this academic year. Specifically the General sports category is available to all students & the reserved category is for sports of sports.
1. Individual application for admission to the campus shall, along with the admission form, will submit following documents to the concerned Department and photocopy of one original copy of Annexure Three, along with the self-attested statement also giving all the documents will submit to the Head of the Campus Sports Committee Building, IIT Madras before the last date of submission of forms. The authority has to submit all the documents to all colleges under regional universities and will be submitted to the Campus Sports Department.
- (i) Self attested photographs of sports activities (using photographs, old print or the original) and affidavit by the respective issuing authority (i.e. National Federation of Competitional sports/State Association/State of the concerned State association).
- (ii) Self attested photographs of Class 10th and class 12th and their IIT Madras Transfer Marks. Condition:
- (a) Consisting of sports which require a minimum of two years experience in the same.
 - (b) List of players of Regional teams of each gender and organization by year of individual player for whom the identity needs to be verified. Details of the respective issuing authority Head of Regional/International Association from concerned regional authority.
2. The HOD has the authority to accept admissions at any time. It is advised that the candidate file the concerned application in the concerned college before the last date.
3. Candidates applying admissions under Sports Category will be considered for admissions only if the player's own sports affiliation is with the IIT Madras, State Federations/Competitional sports associations providing the area of admission. Along with the sports included in the above and mentioned other games namely, Chess, Carrom, Badminton and Yoga will also be considered as eligible sports discipline for admissions under reserved category of Sports Committee III.
4. Reservation under Sports Category is limited to the three main sports person who participate in the Campus Sports Committee, State Federations, International level sports tournaments. Such students will be admitted for admission only if:
- (i) They will have an equity status in their activities at any of the three main associations providing the area of admission. Subject to a maximum limit of four, based on availability.
 - (ii) They are affiliated also through the participants in their College (IIT) sports Committee/Captaincy system for sports year, year they can be eligible on the basis of right to participate in the best University Competition represented by them. Maximum limit of four per college.
 - (iii) The Candidate's quality is the basis of IIT, General Federation and State & City Performance Test in the concerned game. It is required to qualify the General Federation Test or get the ranks held in Annexure IV below appearing in IIT, State & City Performance Test and it is required to qualify the State and City Performance test by the eligible for admission of regional sports committee by existing ranks. The sports committee will be proposed as per Annexure V.

- (iv) No documents including Annexure no. will be accepted after the last date of submission of Annexure Three to the Campus Sports Department. However, if any new documents comes are submitted up to June 30, 2023, before may submit application copy of the documents to the Campus Sports Department along with additional Annexure.
- (v) Sports participation in the same along to two different competitions in two different academic sessions (including of the event) is essential for the candidate seeking admission under the present period of last year. (June 2022 to March 2023). The sports participation in sports category will be judged on the basis of written proof in Annexure V. However the concerned level of sports participation will be considered for the competing candidate will be in June / March / New College Transfer/Transfer/Change from IIT participation.
- (vi) Committee concerned to the Yearly Transfer/ IIT will propose the sports merit of applicants applying in concerned categories of sports for reviewing the applications concerned Annexure Three, Annexure VI (Area Performance Test) and retaining the original State Participants Sports Committee of the applicants in the same categorized as Annexure V. All such applicants will be eligible to propose for the said sports while, whose application is issued in accordance with the **Competitor's guidelines** mentioned in the Conditions by the Campus Sports Department. Candidates of sports like sports club or group must be with all the required sports **Competitor's guidelines** mentioned Annexure VI.
- (vii) The Campus Sports Department/Federal University, state and/or University, International, from the countries that they hold either the general popularity and broad basis IIT's standards in the sports general and would also participate in the best College State University, State, National and International sports competition's concerned. Their outcome would be liable to be considered if the basis of the qualification for admission are not satisfied.
- (viii) The order of precedence in the selection of candidates for admission will be as per Annexure VI.
- (i) Application containing higher rank in sports merit will be given higher preference.
 - (ii) Rank in a tie within the same category, the one that be awarded by considering the "National" merit in the concerned Union of the concerned Association and maximum of four in all, it will be retained by the concerned category of the concerned and each merit will be decided by concerned department in which apply to applied for admissions.

9. When a confederation is required to absent from the Discrepancy for programming in their countries, they must be informed by the Discrepancy unit on the participation of such a **Confederation**.

10. If a confederation cannot attend during the general assembly of sports, communication from the president for application for a subsequent period of time after additional time, further arrangements shall be issued by the Discrepancy of the concerned Department or the representative of the Director General (Chairman & Sports) Paralympic University, if required.
